CLASS 1 Range Wool

* Including Columbia, Rambouillet, Corriedale, Targhee, Merino

CLASS 2 Long Wool

* Including Romney, Lincoln, Leicester, Cotswold, Coopworth

CLASS 3 All Down Breeds

* Including Hampshire, Suffolk, Cheviot, Dorset, Texel, Arcott breeds, East Friesian and Charollais.

CLASS 4 Other Specialty Wools

* Including Icelandic, Shetland, Jacob, Karakul, Coloured

CLASS 5 Crossbred Wools

* From sheep which represent a combination of any two of Class 1, 2, 3 or 4.
(e.g, Long Wool breed x Down breeds)

Fleece competition details:

1. White and natural colored fleeces from sheep in any Canadian province may be entered.
2. Entry fee: \$5.00 per fleece.
3. Deadline for entry forms: May 10, 2010
4. Fleeces must be at the Richmond Exhibition Grounds, Richmond, Quebec, no later than 12 noon, Thursday May 20, 2010.
5. Fleeces should be in the grease, clean and well prepared (skirted).
6. Certificates: a) In each class: First, Second and Honorable Mention.
Ribbons: b) Overall : Supreme Champion Fleece, Reserve Champion Fleece
The judge's decision in all placing will be final.

7. The All Canada Sheep Classic Fleece Competition is a project of the Quebec Purebred Sheep Breeders' Association, Canadian Sheep Breeders' Association (CSBA) and Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers Limited (CCWG) who shall not be liable for any loss or damage occurring to fleeces entered in this competition. Every effort will be made to take good care of the fleeces during the competition, display and auction time.

8. Disbursement of fleeces:

- A. All fleeces received will be offered for sale after the judging by silent auction, the Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion fleece will be auctioned at the banquet.
- B. Each sale fleece will be weighed on location
- C. Bids will be accepted in amount per pound, for the entire fleece.
- D. A minimum bid will be established and published.
- E. Bid opening and closing time will be posted.
- F. Highest bid at closing will be accepted.
- G. All fleeces entered become the property of the All Canada Sheep Classic and are not returnable.
- H. All proceeds from the sale of fleeces will be donated to a recognized charity, the Lois Laberge Foundation.
